Magical Mystery Tour

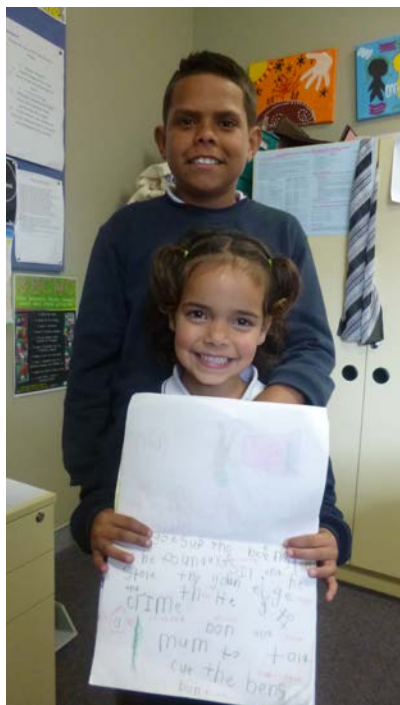

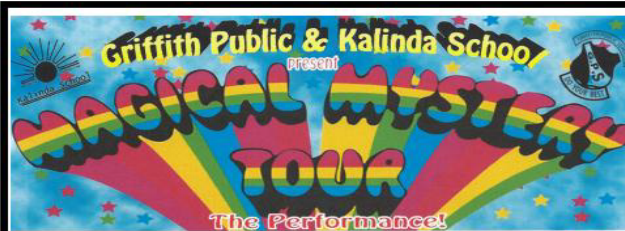

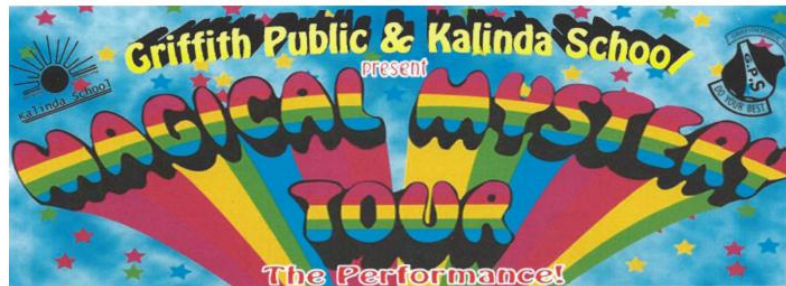
