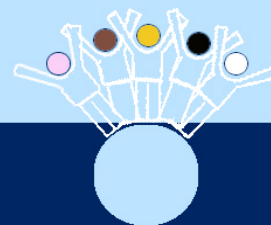

Mortimer Shield Boys Rugby League

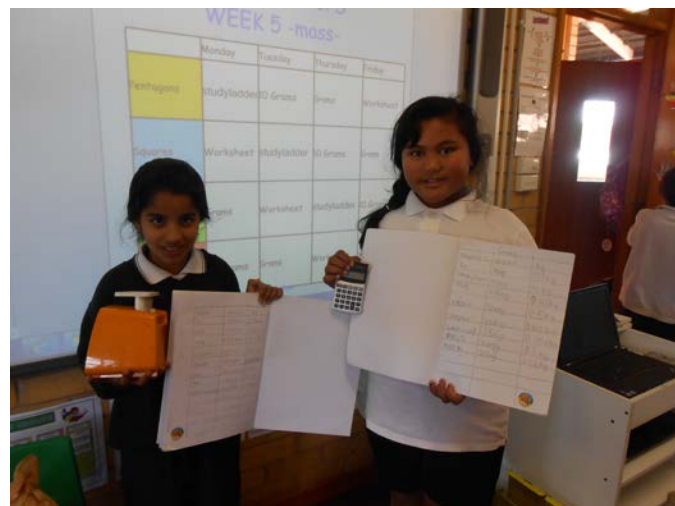
