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### 2020 Presentation Day

The Department of Education released updated COVID-19 operational guidelines to schools for the remainder of 2020 on the 5<sup>th</sup> November, and this included advice on End of Year Presentation Days.

**We have been advised that schools must comply with the 4 square metre rule (4m<sup>2</sup>) for all people participating (this includes guests /parents attending). Seating arrangements must also ensure that there is 1.5 metre between non-household members for any guest/parents who attend.**

**For now, these events must remain on hold.**

**Parent and carer attendance at assemblies and other school events**

**School-based activities that involve large gathering of adults. These include parent/community gatherings such as parent functions, working bees, fundraisers, school barbecues, large parent information evenings and large on-site cultural events**

**This means that unfortunately we cannot accommodate parents and visitors at our Presentation Day this year as we cannot meet the 4m<sup>2</sup> rule in an equitable and fair way.**

The following information outlines how we will be conducting our 2020 Presentation Days.

We are unable to hold Presentation Day at the Regional Theatre as the venue cannot accommodate our students because of COVID-19 regulations.

The outgoing School Captains will present the incoming school captains with their badges at the morning lines as this will allow all K to 6 students to

be present. K to 2 students will then move to the hall where awards will be presented and 3-6 students will go to class as normal. When the K to 2 awards have been presented, 3-6 will then move to the hall where their awards will be presented and K to 2 students will return to class.

We will be videoing (possibly livestreaming) the presentation of awards.

We know this will be a very different style of Presentation Days in this COVID -19 year, however please be assured that we are doing as much as we can within the current guidelines to ensure the students will still enjoy Presentation Day. We thank you for your understanding and support during this challenging time.

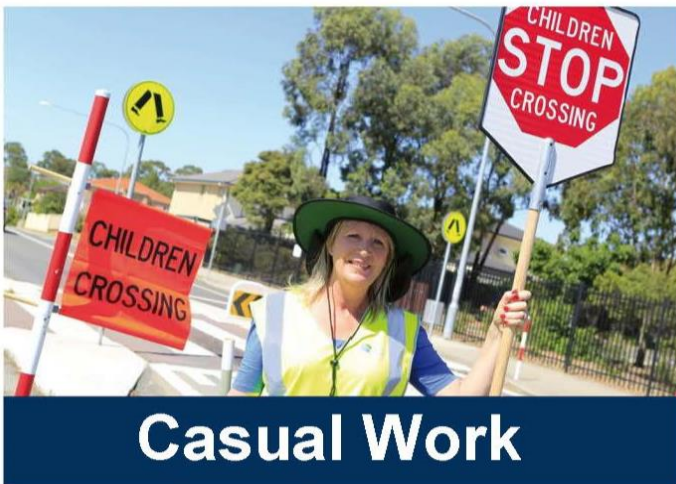
