We have been having a great time in 3C. Here are some highlights from Term 1.



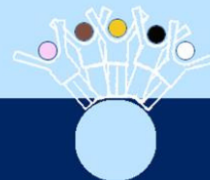
Our watercolour artwork was inspired by this story from our writing unit.



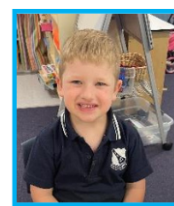
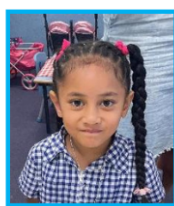
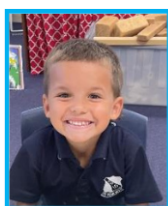
